PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

- **You must be an Orange City Resident and provide:**
- -Photo I.D. with current address **AND**
- -Utility Statement

PROOF OF INCOME:

- You **MUST** provide:
- -Current pay stub(s); **OR** Evidence receiving State/County Assistance such as Food Stamps, Free/Reduced lunch program

PROOF FAMILY SIZE:

- -You **MUST** have Birth Certificate(s), **OR**
- -You **MUST** have guardianship papers **IF** you are not the parent

CHILDREN GRADES VPK-12:

- -Current report card **OR** school ID card

ALL OF THE ABOVE DOCUMENTATION IS NECESSARY TO REGISTER

Residency and income exceptions are made on a case by case basis. Our goal is to help those who need assistance for Christmas. If you or someone you know is struggling to provide food or gifts for their children and you are not sure about qualifying, please call us prior to the sign up dates.

NOTE: **Volusia County** is part of the **Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area**, so all information presented here applies to all of the Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area. HUD generally uses the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) area definitions in the calculation of income limit program parameters. However, to ensure that program parameters do not vary significantly due to area definition changes, HUD has used custom geographic definitions for the Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area.

The **Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area** contains the following areas: Volusia County, FL;

* The FY 2014 Consolidated Appropriations Act changed the definition of extremely low-income to be the greater of 30/50ths (60 percent) of the Section 8 very low-income limit or the poverty guideline as [established by the Department of Health and Human Services \(HHS\)](#), provided that this amount is not greater than the Section 8 50% very low-income limit. Consequently, the extremely low income limits may equal the very low (50%) income limits.
