Registration Requirements:

PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

- You must be an Orange City Resident or neighboring city:
- -Photo I.D. with current address **AND**
- -Utility Statement

PROOF OF INCOME:

- You **MUST** provide:
- -Current paystub(s); **OR** Evidence receiving State/County Assistance such as Food Stamps, Free/reduced Lunch Program

PROOF FAMILY SIZE:

- -You **MUST** have Birth Certificate(s), **OR**
- -You **MUST** have guardianship papers **IF** you are not the parent

CHILDREN GRADES VPK-12:

- -Current report card **OR** school ID card

ALL OF THE ABOVE DOCUMENTATION IS NECESSARY TO REGISTER

Our assistance is offered to residents of Orange City with neighboring towns being placed on a waiting list. After our deadline passes, the Operation Santa committee will make the decision on the neighboring families we can help based on their needs and our current funding situation. Once families have been selected, they will be notified via email and/or phone, and a date and time to pick up their packages. Residency and income exceptions are made on a case by case basis. Our goal is to help those who need assistance for Christmas. If you or someone you know is struggling to provide food or gifts for their children and you are not sure about qualifying, please call us prior to the sign up dates.

To help us select gifts your child will enjoy, please give us an idea of toys they are wishing for that range between \$10 and \$30 each. Our goal is to provide each child with 3 gifts, a game and/or book, and stocking stuffers. The donations that we receive will determine the value and quantity of your food and gift packages.
