PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

- -Photo I.D. with current address AND
- -Utility Statement

PROOF OF INCOME:

- You **MUST** provide:
- -Current pay stub(s); **OR** Evidence receiving State/County Assistance such as Food Stamps, Free/Reduced lunch program

PROOF FAMILY SIZE:

- -You **MUST** have Birth Certificate(s), **OR**
- -You MUST have guardianship papers IF you are not the parent

CHILDREN GRADES VPK-12:

• -Current report card **OR** school ID card

ALL OF THE ABOVE DOCUMENTATION IS NECESSARY TO REGISTER

Residency and income exceptions will be placed on a wait list with Orange City residents given first priority. If you or someone you know is struggling to provide food or gifts for their children and you are not sure about qualifying, please call us prior to the sign up dates.

FY 2024 Income Limits Summary

NOTE: **Volusia County** is part of the **Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area**, so all information presented here applies to all of the Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area. HUD generally uses the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) area definitions in the calculation of income limit program parameters. However, to ensure that program parameters do not vary significantly due to area definition changes, HUD has used custom geographic definitions for the Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area.

The Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach, FL HUD Metro FMR Area contains the following areas: Volusia County, FL;

* The FY 2014 Consolidated Appropriations Act changed the definition of extremely low-income to be the greater of 30/50ths (60 percent) of the Section 8 very low-income limit or the poverty guideline as <u>established by the Department of Health and</u> <u>Human Services (HHS)</u>, provided that this amount is not greater than the Section 8 50% very low-income limit. Consequently, the extremely low income limits may equal the very low (50%) income limits.
